JETS NOTES

- » Improved 3-4-1 in Game 2's of a playoff series, and 2-1-1 in Game 2's on the road.
- » Marked the fourth time in franchise history the team when to overtime in the playoffs. Winnipeg is 2-2 during extra time, three of which have been played on the road (2-1). Winnipeg's first franchise overtime win dates back to the first round of the 2019 Stanley Cup playoffs on April 16/19 with Kyle Connor scoring the game winner in the Jets' 2-1 victory against the St. Louis Blues.
- » Second time in franchise history where the Jets have kicked off a postseason series with a 2-0 lead, the first occasion dates back to the first round series of the 2018 playoffs against the Minnesota Wild.
- » One of only five teams during the 2020-21 playoffs thus far to remain at 100% on the penalty kill.
- » Leads all NHL teams with allowing only one-goal against through two games or more of the 2020-21 postseason.

PAUL STASTNY

- » Marked the game-winning goal at 4:06 of overtime.
- » This is the second overtime goal of Stastny's playoff career. The first he recorded with the Colorado Avalanche, April 17/14 against the Minnesota Wild.

ANDREW COPP

» Recorded the primary assist on Stastny's overtime game-winner, marking the first overtime point of his playoff career.

TUCKER POOLMAN

- » Posted the secondary assist on Stastny's overtime goal, notching the first overtime point of his playoff career.
- » Has recorded points in back-to-back contests.

MARK SCHEIFELE

» Recorded five blocks during tonight's game, setting a new postseason single-game high.

KYLE CONNOR

» Led the Jets with seven shots registered during the game, setting a new playoff single-game high.
