JETS NOTES

- » The Jets are 3-5 in Game 3's during the postseason, and 2-2 in Game 3's on home ice.
- » Winnipeg is 3-2 in playoff overtime decisions, and 1-1 in playoff overtime contests on home ice.
- » This is the first time in franchise history that the club has kicked off a series with a 2-0 load
- » The last time the club erased a three-goal deficit was on May 1 of the 2018 Stanley Cup playoffs when the Jets won 7-4 against the Nashville Predators in Game Three, which was also played on home ice.
- » This is the first time in Winnipeg's playoff history that the club has gone to overtime in back-to-back contests.
- » The Jets tied a franchise record with 48 shots allowed.
- » Both teams recorded their first power play goal of the series during tonight's game.

PLAYER NOTES

NIKOLAJ EHLERS

- » Scored the first overtime winner of his playoff career for Winnipeg, joining Kyle Connor and Paul Stastny who have also scored playoff overtime winners for the Jets.
- » Notched Winnipeg's second period goal on a man advantage, tallying the Jets' first power play marker of the 2021 Stanley Cup playoffs.
- » This was Ehlers second power play goal of his playoff career, the first he posted in the Qualifying Round of the 2019 Stanley Cup playoffs, Aug. 3/20 against the Calgary Flames
- » Joined Blake Wheeler, Kyle Connor and Mathieu Perreault, who are in a four-way tie for third on Winnipeg's franchise leader board with two power play goals scored during their playoff careers.
- » Recorded the second multi-point game of his playoff career, the first dating back to May 5/18 against the Nashville Predators.

PIERRE-LUC DUBOIS

- » Recorded the primary assist on Ehlers' power play goal and the secondary assist on Mathieu Perreault's third period goal, marking the sixth multi-point game of his playoff career.
- » Paced the club with four shots.

- » Contributed on both of Winnipeg's overtime goals during the 2021 Stanley Cup playoffs.

- » Stopped 44 of 48 shots he faced in the win.
