JETS NOTES

- » Improved to 4-0-0 at Canada Life Centre this season.
- » Have earned points in eight consecutive games (6-0-2), tying the second-longest streak in franchise history, and matching the longest streak since relocation. The Atlanta Thrashers earned points in nine straight games Dec. 9-28/05. The Jets earned points in eight consecutive games three other times with the last coming Jan. 20-Feb. 6/18.
- » Scored four or more goals for the sixth time this season, which is now tied for second in the NHL. It was the Jets' fourth game this season with five or more goals, which is also tied for second in the NHL.
- » Have won six straight regular season home games dating back to May 11/21.
- » Scored a power play goal for an eighth time in the past eight games (9-for-23, 39%). The Jets now rank third in the NHL on the power play (29%).
- » Outshot Chicago 33·18, and have posted 30-plus shots on goal in four straight games. Held Chicago to single-digit shots in all three periods.
