JETS NOTES

- » Improve to 14-10-1 at Canada Life Centre this season.
- » Tied a season-high with eight goals (Dec. 3 vs. New Jersey).
- » 14th game in franchise history scoring eight or more goals (franchise record is nine goals, accomplished three times).
- » Nine different skaters had multiple points.
- » Have scored five or more goals four times in the past eight games.
- » Tied a season-high scoring three power play goals (Dec. 5 vs. Toronto, Feb. 12 at Nashville).
- » Tied a season-high scoring four goals in the first period. Also scored four goals in the second period on Dec. 5 vs. Toronto and in the third period on Feb. 16 vs. Minnesota.
- » 26.67 shot percentage in a game (8-for-30) is tied for 24th in franchise history, and highest rate since Dec. 31/19 at Colorado (26.9% in 7-4 win).
- » Outhit Montreal 31-17
- » Finished 38-for-60 (63%) on face-offs with all centres winning at least 50 per cent.
- » Killed off five of six power plays. The Jets' penalty kill is now 36-for-41 (88%) in the past 13 games, and 76-for-89 (85%) over the past 29 games.

PLAYER NOTES

NATHAN BEAULIEU

- » Finished plus-2 and tied for the team lead with four hits. The four hits tied a season-high (Feb. 27 at Arizona).

KYLE CONNOR

- » Had three assists, and now has 29 points in his past 24 games.
- » 18th multi-point game of the season.
- » Fifth career game with three or more assists.
- » Led Jets' forwards in time on ice at 19:53.

ANDREW COPP

- » Scored a goal and an assist in first game since Feb. 16 vs. Minnesota.
- » Seventh multi-point game of the season.

BRENDEN DILLON

- » Tied for the team lead with four hits.
- » Also led the team with a season-high four blocked shots. Had three blocked shots in seven previous games.

PIERRE-LUC DUBOIS

- » Scored a goal and two assists for 11th multi-point game of the season. The three points are also a season-high and mark his 14th career game with three or more points.
- » Scored 96th career goal.
- » Now has seven points in his past three games.
- » Led the Jets with six shots on goal, and has led the Jets each of the past three games (19 total shots).
