Winnipeg Jets: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Rick Bowness

Rick Bowness was appointed as the eighth head coach in franchise history on July 3, 2022 and the third head coach since the club's relocation to Winnipeg.

Bowness, 67, most recently served as head coach of the Dallas Stars from Dec. 10/19 until the end of the 2021-22 season. The Moncton, N.B. native led the Stars to an 89-62-25 record in 176 regular season games. Dallas also went 18-16 in the playoffs, highlighted by a trip to the 2020 Stanley Cup Final.

Bowness was drafted in the second round in the 1975 NHL Draft by the Atlanta Flames. Bowness played 45 games for the Jets 1.0 in the 1980-81 season and he played and coached with the organization for nine seasons until 1988-89.

Following his time with the Jets, Bowness has served in a number of different coaching capacities at the NHL level for the Boston Bruins, Ottawa Senators, New York Islanders, Phoenix Coyotes, Vancouver Canucks, Tampa Bay Lightning, and Dallas. He has a 212-351-76 record as an NHL head coach.

Kyle Connor paced the Jets in scoring in the pre-season with eight points (4G, 4A) in three games, while Nikolaj Ehlers had five points (2G, 3A) in a trio of games... Goaltender David Rittich went 1-1-0 with a 1.88 goals-against average, a .932 save percentage, and a shutout in a pair of pre-season appearances.

Season Openers

The Jets are 6-3-0 in their past nine season openers... Winnipeg is starting a season at home for the second time in the past three seasons and seventh time since relocation in 2011... The Jets have scored at least four goals in six of their past eight season-opening games... Blake Wheeler has 13 points (7G, 6A) in 11 season opening games with the franchise. He is slated to tie Bryan Little for the franchise record for playing season openers... Kyle Connor has a point in each of the five season openers he's played, including a goal in each of the past four.

The Jets begin the 2022-23 with five players on the roster that weren't with the team previously: G – David Rittich, D – Kyle Capobianco, F – Sam Gagner, F – Axel Jonsson-Fjällby, and F – Saku Mäenalanen... Rittich, Capobianco, Gagner, and Mäenalanen were signed as free agents, while Jonsson-Fjällby was claimed off waivers from the Washington Capitals earlier this week.

On the Docket

Aside from opening the season at Canada Life Centre, other highlights of the home schedule include Patrik Laine and the Columbus Blue Jackets coming to Winnipeg on Dec. 2... Former head coach Paul Maurice, after nine seasons as the Jets bench boss, brings his new team - the President Trophy winning Florida Panthers - to Canada Life Centre on Dec. 6... The longest homestand of the season is the final one on the schedule, which spans five games from Mar. 31-Apr. 10... Winnipeg doesn't play from Jan. 31-Feb. 10, as the NHL All-Star Weekend takes place on Feb. 3-4 in Florida, followed by the club's five-day player break... January also features the Jets' longest road trip of the campaign, as they will play five straight contests away from Manitoba from Jan. 17-24... December is the team's busiest month, with the Jets playing 16 games in total – nine at home and seven on the road. Winnipeg's first 15 road games of the season are against Western Conference teams... The Jets first visit to the Eastern Conference is not until back-to-back games on Dec. 22-23 at Boston and Washington... Winnipeg plays 13 back-to-backs this season: eleven are consecutive games as the visiting team and two feature a game at Canada Life Centre and a game on the road.

Home Comforts

Winnipeg went 23-15-3 at home last season, which ranked 15th in the NHL with 49 points... The Jets won their last four home games to close out the season, outscoring their opposition 15-5 in the four games... Winnipeg also started the season with four consecutive wins in their first four games at Canada Life Centre... The Jets outscored their opposition 140-115 in the 41 home games and 13 of the 23 wins came by three goals or more... Winnipeg's 140 goals on home ice were 10th in the NHL... Winnipeg finished ninth in the NHL with a 52.0% faceoff winning percentage... Winnipeg is 229-149-36 all-time at Canada Life Centre and have posted a .500 record or better at home in six consecutive seasons.

On The Power Play

The Jets finished 17th in the NHL with a power play that clicked at 21.1%... It was the fifth consecutive season the power play has finished better than 20.0%... Winnipeg's 52 power play goals was the most in the past three seasons... The Jets longest streak with a power play goal was five games from Dec. 17-Jan. 6... Kyle Connor led the Jets with 28 power play points (8G, 20A) last season... Pierre-Luc Dubois led the team with 15 power play goals, which is a career high. His previous best was six power play goals as a rookie with the Columbus Blue Jackets in 2017-18.

Extra Time

Winnipeg was 7-11 in games that went to extra time last season, including 5-7 in overtime and 2-4 in shootouts... The 11 overtime/shootout losses is tied for sixth most in the NHL... The franchise record for overtime/shootout losses in a season is 13, which happened during the 2009-10 and 2014-15 seasons... Seven of Winnipeg's 12 overtime games happened on the road last season... Mark Scheifele (twice), Kyle Connor, Pierre-Luc Dubois, and Nikolaj Ehlers scored Winnipeg's overtime goals this season... Two of Winnipeg's five overtime goals last season were scored within the first 32 seconds of the overtime period.

Goal-Games

Winnipeg finished the season 12-5-11 in one-goal games... Meanwhile, the Jets were 10-12 in games decided by two goals and 17-15 in games decided by three goals or more.

Zeros

The Jets had five shutouts last season, which is two shy of the franchise record... The Jets beat the Seattle Kraken on Dec. 9 and Detroit Red Wings on Jan. 13 by a 3-0 score, while they shut out Minnesota 2-0 on Jan. 8, Vegas 4-0 on Mar. 22, and Philadelphia 4-0 on Apr. 27... Winnipeg was shut out four times this season as well.

Afternoon Meetings

The Jets went 5-4-2 in afternoon games last season... Kyle Connor led the Jets in scoring in day games with 10 points (8G, 2A) in 11 games... Goaltender Eric Comrie was a perfect 3-0-0 in afternoon games with a .277 goals-against average and .911 save percentage.

KC Wins The Byng

Kyle Connor won the NHL's Lady Byng Trophy last season, given "to the player adjudged to have exhibited the best type of sportsmanship and gentlemanly conduct combined with a high standard of playing ability."... Connor had just four penalty minutes en route to tallying 93 points (47G, 46A).

Single-Season Records

Kyle Connor finished third in franchise history with 47 goals last season. The most goals in a season in franchise history is 52, which Ilya Kovalchuk did in 2005-06 and 2007-08. Connor passed Patrik Laine (44 in 2017-18) for the most goals in a season since relocation... Kyle Connor ended the season fourth in franchise history with 93 points last season, which is the most since relocation. It's the eighth time in franchise history a player has reached the 90-point mark in a season... Pierre-Luc Dubois' 15 power play goals ended the season tied for eighth in franchise history and are the most since Patrik Laine had 15 power play tallies in 2018-19... Kyle Connor and Adam Lowry each had three shorthanded goals this season, which ranks tied for fourth in franchise history. Only three players in franchise history have scored four or more shorthanded goals in a season.

28 or More

For the first time in franchise history, the Jets had four players score 28 goals or more in a season... Aside from Kyle Connor's team-leading 47 goals, Mark Scheifele had 29 goals, while Pierre-Luc Dubois and Nikolaj Ehlers had 28 goals each... The previous high was three, which was done five times.

Defensive Offence

Winnipeg's defencemen accounted for 32.7% of the team's assists and 24.2% of points... Josh Morrissey led the Jets defencemen in scoring with 37 points (12G, 25A) in 79 games... Neal Pionk had the most assists among rearguards with 31... Brenden Dillon boasted a plus-16 rating in 79 games, while Dylan DeMelo was plus-10 in 76 contests.

Home Cookin'

Kyle Connor led the Jets in scoring at home with 41 points (21G, 20A) in 40 games... Mark Scheifele's 22 home goals last season is tied for sixth most in a season in franchise history... Scheifele also had the single-season franchise record 25.3% shooting percentage at home this season... - New York completes its first of 16 sets of back-to-back games with a tonight's matchup. Last year, the Blueshirts had a 8-5-1 mark in the second half of back-to-backs. New York ranked eighth in the NHL in 2021-22 with its .607 points percentage in the back half of back-to-back games.
- The Blueshirts have begun a season 2-0-0 for the first time since 2019-20 when they also went 2-0-0. A win tonight would give New York its first 3-0-0 start since the 2015-16 campaign when they Chicago and Columbus (twice). In team history, the longest win streak to begin a season came in 2008-09 (5-0-0).

STRONG START

The Rangers began their 2022-23 season with a 3-1 win over Tampa Bay in a Eastern Conference Final rematch, outshooting them 39-26 in the process and then followed it up with a 7-3 trouncing over the Minnesota Wild on the road.

In their first two games, the Blueshirts have...

- Outscored their opponents 10-4 and have averaged 37 shots on goal.
- Scored twice on the power play
- Eight different goal scorers and 13 different point getters
- Nine players with a plus/minus of two or better
- Killed off eight of their 10 penalty kills
- Scored five goals in the third period
- Won 56.2 percent of faceoffs.

THE CAPTAIN'S 600TH

Tonight, against the team he was drafted by and in the city he began his career, Rangers captain Jacob Trouba will skate in his 600th career NHL game. Trouba spent his 408 games with Winnipeg and has played 191 games for the Rangers. Among NHL defensemen since the 2013-14 season, Trouba's first year, he ranks 11th in blocked shots with 1,209.

Trouba will become the fourth current Ranger to have 600 or more games on his resume.

On August 9, 2022, the Rangers named defenseman Jacob Trouba the 28th captain in franchise history and their first since 2017-18. The Rochester, Michigan native is the fourth straight American-born skater the Rangers have selected as captain making the Blueshirts the first franchise in NHL history to have four consecutive full-time American-born captains (Trouba, McDonagh, Callahan, Drury).

Last season, Trouba scored a career-high 11 goals and notched 28 assists for 39 points in 81 games, as well as posting a career-high plus-25 rating. His 11 goals were tied with Adam Fox for the most among Rangers defenseman in 2021-22. Trouba tallied 177 blocked shots last year, the second most in the NHL, to go along with his 207 hits. He was the only player in the NHL in 2021-22 to record both 175-plus blocked shots and 200-plus hits and was the first Ranger since Dan Girardi in 2014-15 to notch both in the same season.

YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS

Based on opening day rosters, the Rangers are the ninth-youngest team in the NHL at an average age of 27.0 years old. The Blueshirts are the only team in the top-10 of youngest rosters to have made the playoffs last season:

In addition, New York has nine players on their season-opening roster that were drafted by the club.

ROAD WARRIORS

Away from Madison Square Garden last season, the Rangers were 25-14-2 for 52 points, ranking tied for first in road wins and tied for seventh in road points. Their 25 wins were tied for the third most in team history.

On the road, the Rangers' 27.8 power play percentage ranked second in the league and second in franchise history for a single season (1978-79 - 28.9).

MIKA'S MISSION

Mika Zibanejad followed up his opening night performance (two goals) with two assists on Thursday. Zibanejad's assist was the 200th with the Rangers.

Only three players have extended their multi-point streak to start the season to three games: Chris Kreider (3 GP in 2016-17), Bernie Nicholls (3 GP in 1990-91) and Mike McEwen (3 GP in 1978-79).

He raced out to a fast start in New York's opener on Tuesday night, scoring two goals - one shorthanded and one on the power play - and recording a team-high nine shots. It marked the fourth time in his career he has collected a SHG and PPG in the same game (10/11/22 vs. TBL, 3/17/21 vs. PHI, 10/5/19 at OTT, 10/23/18 vs. FLA).

Zibanejad became the fifth player since 1933-34 (since goals by type were tracked) to score a shorthanded goal and a power-play goal in their team's season-opening game. The others: George Armstrong (Oct. 10, 1962 w/ TOR), Adam Graves (Oct. 5, 1996 w/ NYR), Matt Cooke (Oct. 6, 2011 w/ PIT) and Alex Ovechkin (Oct. 13, 2021 w/ WSH).

His nine shorthanded tallies with the Rangers rank ninth in team history. Overall, it was Zibanejad's 11th career goal shorthanded. In addition, Zibanejad's nine shots on goal tied a career-high he previously set on March 14, 2018 against Pittsburgh.

In 2021-22, Zibanejad recorded regular season career-highs in assists (52) and points (81) and was a team-leading plus-30. In addition, he had career-high tying 15 power play goals. Zibanejad was one of three centers in the NHL last season (Barkov, Lindholm) to record 80-plus points and a plus-30 rating or better.

In the 2022 Stanley Cup Playoffs, Zibanejad finished tied for sixth in the NHL with 24 points and tied for seventh in goals (10). Zibanejad also had six power play tallies, matching Adam Graves' six in 1996 for the most by a Ranger in a single postseason.

PANARIN'S POINTS

Artemi Panarin has wasted no time in this young season as he posted his 16th career four-point game with one goal and three assists on Thursday.. Since he entered the NHL in 2015-16, only four players have more: Connor McDavid (23), Nikita Kucherov (19), Leon Draisaitl (18) and Patrick Kane (17).

On Tuesday night, Artemi Panarin recorded his 250th point with as Ranger (71G-179A).

In 2021-22, Artemi Panarin recorded a career-high 74 assists and 96 points, becoming the first forward in team history to record 74 assists in a season. His assist total was third most in a single season by a Ranger, behind Brian Leetch (1991-92 - 80) and Sergei Zubov (1993-94 - 77).

Panarin's 96 points were the most by a Ranger since Jaromir Jagr in 2006-07 and tied for the 11th most in team history.

VEZINA WORTHY-WINNER

In 2021-22, Igor Shesterkin became the sixth Ranger to win the Vezina Trophy, given "to the goaltender adjudged to be the best at his position," as selected by NHL general managers. Shesterkin joined Henrik Lundqvist (2011-12), John Vanbiesbrouck (1985-86), Ed Giacomin & Gilles Villemure* (1970-71), and Dave Kerr (1939-40) with the recognition.

Last season, Shesterkin led the NHL with a 2.07 goals-against average and .935 save percentage, while tallying a 36-13-4 record and six shutouts. He became the third goaltender in NHL history (min. 50 appearances) to post a save percentage

of .935 or higher in a single season, joining Tim Thomas (2010-11 - .938) and Dominik Hasek (1998-99 - .937). Shesterkin's 36 wins ranked sixth in the NHL and his six shutouts ranked third in the league.

KREIDING INTO A 12th SEASON

Chris Kreider, the longest tenured active Ranger, broke both personal and franchise records in 2021-22 with a 52-goal output and 26 coming on the power play. Kreider set franchise records in power play goals (26) and game-winning goals (11), while his 52 goals tied Adam Graves (1993-94) for the second most goals in franchise history. Kreider's season marked the 17th time in NHL history that a player has recorded 52+ goals and 26+ power play goals in a season, the most recent before Kreider was Ilya Kovalchuk in 2005-06 with Atlanta.

In addition, Kreider is the only player in NHL history to record 50+ goals, 25+ power play goals, three+ shorthanded goals and 10+ game winning goals in the same season.

NEW BLUESHIRTS

The Rangers added multiple players through free agent signings and trades this offseason, including forwards Ryan Carpenter and Vincent Trocheck as well as goaltender Jaroslav Halak.

Carpenter notched three goals and nine assists for 12 points in 67 games with the Calgary Flames (8 GP) and Chicago Blackhawks (59 GP) in 2021-22. Prior to being dealt by Chicago on March 21, 2022, Carpenter ranked tied for third on the club in faceoff percentage (min. 100 faceoffs) with a 52.3 percent clip and third in shorthanded time-on-ice (128:14).

Trocheck skated in 81 games for the Carolina Hurricanes in 2021-22, registering 21 goals and 30 assists for 51 points and a career-high plus-21 rating. Trocheck ranked third on the Hurricanes with a career-high 185 hits, tied for fourth in points and fifth in goals. He was one of four players in the NHL last season with 50 or more points and 180 or more hits (Trocheck, Tom Wilson, Brady Tkachuk, Andrei Svechnikov). Among NHL skaters with 1,200 or more faceoffs taken, he ranked 13th in the league with a 54.6 faceoff percentage. In addition, the Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania native led all Carolina forwards in blocked shots (46) and ranked second among forwards in ice time per game (17:52) and takeaways (50).

Halak has appeared in 556 career NHL games (531 starts), split between the Vancouver Canucks (2021-22), Boston Bruins (2018-19 - 2020-21), New York Islanders (2014-15 - 2017-18), Washington Capitals (2013-14), St. Louis Blues (2010-11 - 2013-14), and Montreal Canadiens (2006-07 - 2009-10). He has compiled a 285-18-4 record, .916 save percentage and 2.49 goals against average across 16 NHL seasons. The Bratislava, Slovakia native made 17 appearances (14 starts) in his first season with the Canucks in 2021-22, posting a 4-7-2 record, 2.94 goals against average and .903 save percentage. He made a season-high 39 saves on November 28, 2021 at Boston.

FOX'S FURY

Rangers defenseman Adam Fox followed up his Norris Trophy winning season in 2020-21 with a strong year on the blueline in 2021-22. Last year, Fox ranked third among NHL defensemen in assists (63) and fourth in points (74). Fox's point total was the ninth most in franchise history by a defenseman and his assist total was the fifth most in a single season by a Rangers defenseman.

Fox followed up his regular season with five goals and 18 assists for 23 points in 20 playoff games. He ranked second behind Cale Makar (29) for playoff points among defensemen.

THE KIDS, THE KIDS, THE KIDS

Last year in the playoffs, the forward line of Filip Chytil (*22), Kaapo Kakko (21) and Alexis Lafrenière (20) combined to lead a charge of youth through the Rangers lineup. Those three combined for 33 points in the postseason with Chytil and Lafrenière each recording nine points. *Ages at time of playoffs. Only four skaters in Rangers history recorded more postseason goals before age 23 than Chytil's seven last spring.

Thus far in 2022-23, Kakko and Chytil have scored goals while Lafreniere registered his first career multi-assist game on October 13 at Minnesota.

A LOOK BACK AT 2021-22

With a new president and general manager in Chris Drury and a new head coach in Gerard Gallant, the Rangers brought a new look to last season and turned it into 52 wins and a trip to the Eastern Conference Final.

The Rangers ranked sixth in the NHL in wins, tied for seventh in points, and tied for fourth in regulation wins. The Blueshirts' 52 wins were tied for second most in team history (2014-15 - 53) and their 110 points were the third most in a single season in franchise history behind 2014-15 (113) and 1993-94 (112).

In addition, last year the Rangers were the 10th team in NHL history and first since Pittsburgh in 2011-12 to finish with at least 50 wins, at least 100 points, and have a 50-goal scorer, a 90-point scorer, and a goalie with at least 36 wins.
