Winnipeg Jets: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Rick Bowness

Rick Bowness was appointed as the eighth head coach in franchise history on July 3, 2022 and the third head coach since the club's relocation to Winnipeg.

Bowness, 67, most recently served as head coach of the Dallas Stars from Dec. 10/19 until the end of the 2021-22 season. The Moncton, N.B. native led the Stars to an 89-62-25 record in 176 regular season games. Dallas also went 18-16 in the playoffs, highlighted by a trip to the 2020 Stanley Cup Final.

Bowness was drafted in the second round in the 1975 NHL Draft by the Atlanta Flames. Bowness played 45 games for the Jets 1.0 in the 1980-81 season and he played and coached with the organization for nine seasons until 1988-89.

Following his time with the Jets, Bowness has served in a number of different coaching capacities at the NHL level for the Boston Bruins, Ottawa Senators, New York Islanders, Phoenix Coyotes, Vancouver Canucks, Tampa Bay Lightning, and Dallas. He has a 212-351-76 record as an NHL head coach.

Thompson's performance in Calgary on Tuesday night makes him 2-1-0 with a 2.03 goals-against average and .938 save percentage on the season thus far. In two career starts in his hometown of Calgary, Thompson has stopped 73 of 77 shots (.948).

Aye-Aye Captain!

Golden Knights captain **Mark Stone** assisted on **Brett Howden's** goal on Tuesday night, putting him just one assist away from 300 in his career. Stone has three points in the last four games (1G, 2A) including his goal that sealed the Vegas victory against Los Angeles with just 26 seconds remaining in regulation. Stone's goal marked the 180th of his career and his 33rd game-winning NHL goal. Stone has a history of a strong offensive presence for the Golden Knights; in his first two full seasons in Vegas, Stone posted consecutive 20-goal seasons. Last season despite only appearing in 37 games due to injury, Stone was able to record 30 points. Stone has skated in 179 games for the Golden Knights, owning 57 goals and 111 assists good for 168 total points. Stone was named the first captain in franchise history entering the 2020-21 season.

Spreading the Wealth

After the Golden Knights' 3-2 loss against the Flames on Tuesday, 16 different Vegas players on the 23-man roster have recorded at least one point in the first four games of the season. **Brett Howden's** goal in the first period against Calgary was his first goal of the season and gave **Brayden McNabb** his first point to make them the 15th and 16th Vegas players to record a point on the year. This ties the franchise record of most Golden Knights players to have recorded one or more points in the opening four games of the season (2020-21). **William Carrier** also tallied his first goal of the season against the Flames, making Howden and Carrier the 9th and 10th Golden Knights to have scored at least one goal in the opening four contests of the season. Vegas has not seen this much variety in scoring since the 2020-21 season (also 10 different players in 4 games played). **Jonathan Marchessault** currently leads Vegas with 3 goals for 3 points, followed by **Jack Eichel** (1G, 2A), **Mark Stone** (1G, 2A), with **Alex Pietrangelo**, **Chandler Stephenson**, and **Nicolas Roy** (0G, 3A).

The Iron Man

Phil Kessel joined the Golden Knights roster in August after skating for two seasons with the Coyotes. A two-time Stanley Cup champion (2015-16, 2016-17), Kessel has 957 points (399 G, 558 A) in 1,208 career NHL games. He ranks eighth among players who appeared in 2021-22 in career games played and 10th in career points and is one goal shy of becoming the 13th American-born player to score 400 NHL goals. Kessel has appeared in 986 consecutive NHL contests, the longest active streak and three games away from tying Keith Yandle's all-time record of 989.

The Marchessault Man

Vegas forward **Jonathan Marchessault** leads the Golden Knights in points after notching his second and third goals of the season Saturday night against the Seattle Kraken. Marchessault recorded three goals in the first three games. Marchessault sat at the top last season for Vegas with 66 points (30G, 36A) in 76 games, including four multi-goal games. Marchessault was the only member of the Golden Knights to hit the 30-goal mark during the 2021-22 campaign. Marchessault also led in shots (251) and was second in assists (36), power-play goals (5), and game-winning goals (5). Entering his sixth season as a Golden Knight, Marchessault has appeared in 356 total games and has recorded 291 points (122G, 169A) with Vegas, both franchise highs. In his NHL career, Marchessault has played in 480 games and recorded 361 points (160G, 201A) through nine seasons spent with the Golden Knights, Panthers, Lightning, and Blue Jackets.

Hill Makes His Debut

Adin Hill made his debut as a Golden Knight in Saturday's victory 5-2 against the Kraken. Joining Vegas this past off-season, Hill made his first start and win with the organization and faced 33 shots (31 saves). Hill's performance in net on Saturday puts him at a .939 save percentage and a 2.00 goals-against-average.

Cotter the Kid!

Paul Cotter netted the lone goal for the Golden Knights in a 1-0 victory over the Chicago Blackhawks last Thursday night. Cotter becomes the first player to debut with Vegas and score three goals in his first nine games with the franchise. The 22-year-old from Canton, Michigan has continued to shine for the Golden Knights this year, beginning in the preseason. Cotter remained in the top three of point-leaders for the preseason and was one of three players who appeared in six or more of the seven exhibition games. Cotter's goal Thursday marks his third point as a Golden Knight (3G, 0A) and the first game-winning goal of his career.

Looking Back at Inaugural Success

Vegas enters its sixth season as a franchise after making its debut on October 6, 2017, with a 2-1 win at Dallas. Vegas is the only expansion team in the last 28 years to earn a season-opening victory in its inaugural campaign. The Golden Knights started their inaugural season 8-2-0 in their first 10 games. The NHL's newest club, the Seattle Kraken, matched up with Vegas in their first game as a franchise on October 12, 2021, as the Golden Knights skated to a 4-3 victory at T-Mobile Arena.

New Bench Bosses

The Vegas Golden Knights welcomed a few new faces to their coaching staff this offseason. **Bruce Cassidy** joined as the third head coach in franchise history. Serving most recently as bench boss for the Boston Bruins, Cassidy has had great success in his coaching career. During Cassidy's tenure as the 28th head coach in Boston, the Bruins qualified for the postseason in each of his six seasons behind the bench. Cassidy and the Bruins reached the Stanley Cup Final in 2019, falling short in seven games against the St. Louis Blues. In the following season, Cassidy led Boston to the best record in the NHL (44-14-12) and won the Jack Adams Award as the top coach in 2019-20. Cassidy also previously served on the coaching staffs of the Washington Capitals (2002-03) and the Chicago Blackhawks (2005-06). **John Stevens** joined the Golden Knights as assistant coach after most recently serving as an assistant coach of the Dallas Stars. Stevens, also with a history of great success both as assistant coach and head coach in his career, won the Stanley Cup twice with Los Angeles (2012, 2014). Finally, **Sean Burke** joined the Golden Knights as goaltending coach after having experience with the Arizona Coyotes and Montreal Canadiens in various roles, including assistant general manager, goaltending coach, scout, and director of player development. In addition, Burke has extensive international experience, serving as general manager of several Canadian Men's National Teams since 2016-17.

Shots on Shots on Shots

The Golden Knights had 51 shots on goal against the Kings in their opener, tied for the most in a regulation game in franchise history (t-5th in any game). Vegas' 51 shots also mark a new franchise record for most shots on goal in a season opening game. The previous record for the Golden Knights was 35 which was set back in 2019. **Jack Eichel** and **Jonathan Marchessault** led the Golden Knights with seven shots each on the night.

Pair of Apples

Mason Appleton's two assists on Wednesday marked the third two-assist game of his career... He had two assists in 19 games with the Jets last season after being reacquired from the Seattle Kraken.

Ice Loggers

Neal Pionk leads the Jets with an average of 22:36 ice time per game, which is the second highest of his career... Josh Morrissey is second on the team with an average ice time of 21:25, which is his lowest since 2017-18 when he averaged 20:27... Kyle Connor paces Jets forwards in average ice time with 20:31.

Back-2-Back

The Jets are in the middle of playing the first of 12 back-to-back sets on their schedule this season... The Jets were 6-4-2 in the first game of a back-to-back last season and 5-5-2 in the second game for an overall record of 11-9-4.

The Moncton, N.B. native led the Stars to an 89-62-25 record in 176 regular season games and a trip to the 2020 Stanley Cup Final... Scott Arniel is the team's new associate coach, while Brad Lauer and Marty Johnston serve as assistant coaches. Amiel was most recently with the Washington Capitals, while Brad Lauer is coming off a WHL championship as the head coach of the Edmonton Oil Kings and Marty Johnston was promoted from the Manitoba Moose... Assistant coach Wade Flaherty returns to guide the team's goaltenders.

New Faces

The Jets begin the 2022-23 with five players on the roster that weren't with the team previously: G – David Rittich, D – Kyle Capobianco, F – Sam Gagner, F – Axel Jonsson-Fjällby, and F – Saku Mäenalanen...Rittich, Capobianco, Gagner, and Mäenalanen were signed as free agents, while Jonsson-Fjällby was claimed off waivers from the Washington Capitals last week.

On the Docket

Aside from opening the season at Canada Life Centre, other highlights of the home schedule include Patrik Laine and the Columbus Blue Jackets coming to Winnipeg on Dec. 2... Former head coach Paul Maurice, after nine seasons as the Jets bench boss, brings his new team - the President Trophy winning Florida Panthers - to Canada Life Centre on Dec. 6... The longest homestand of the season is the final one on the schedule, which spans five games from Mar. 31-Apr. 10... Winnipeg doesn't play from Jan. 31-Feb. 10, as the NHL All-Star Weekend takes place on Feb. 3-4 in Florida, followed by the club's five-day player break... January also features the Jets' longest road trip of the campaign, as they will play five straight contests away from Manitoba from Jan. 17-24... December is the team's busiest month, with the Jets playing 16 games in total

– nine at home and seven on the road. Winnipeg's first 15 road games of the season are against Western Conference teams... The Jets first visit to the Eastern Conference is not until back-to-back games on Dec. 22-23 at Boston and Washington... Winnipeg plays 13 back-to-backs this season: eleven are consecutive games as the visiting team and two feature a game at Canada Life Centre and a game on the road.

Home Comforts

Winnipeg went 23-15-3 at home last season, which ranked 15th in the NHL with 49 points... The Jets won their last four home games to close out the season, outscoring their opposition 15-5 in the four games... Winnipeg also started the season with four consecutive wins in their first four games at Canada Life Centre... The Jets outscored their opposition 140-115 in the 41 home games and 13 of the 23 wins came by three goals or more... Winnipeg's 140 goals on home ice were 10th in the NHL... Winnipeg finished ninth in the NHL with a 52.0% faceoff winning percentage... After Friday's win, Winnipeg is 230-149-36 all-time at Canada Life Centre and have posted a .500 record or better at home in six consecutive seasons.

On The Power Play

The Jets are 2-for-10 on the power play to start the season... Sam Gagner scored Winnipeg's lone power play goal on Wednesday, which was his first since May 8/21 at CBJ... The Jets finished 17th in the NHL with a power play that clicked at 21.1% last season... It was the fifth consecutive season the power play has finished better than 20.0%... Winnipeg's 52 power play goals was the most in the previous three seasons... The Jets longest streak with a power play goal was five games from Dec. 17-Jan. 6... Kyle Connor led the Jets with 28 power play points (8G, 20A) last season... Pierre-Luc Dubois led the team with 15 power play goals, which is a career high. His previous best was six power play goals as a rookie with the Columbus Blue Jackets in 2017-18.

Extra Time

Winnipeg was 7-11 in games that went to extra time last season, including 5-7 in overtime and 2-4 in shootouts... The 11 overtime/shootout losses is tied for sixth most in the NHL... The franchise record for overtime/shootout losses in a season is 13, which happened during the 2009-10 and 2014-15 seasons... Seven of Winnipeg's 12 overtime games happened on the road last season... Mark Scheifele (twice), Kyle Connor, Pierre-Luc Dubois, and Nikolaj Ehlers scored Winnipeg's overtime goals this season... Two of Winnipeg's five overtime goals last season were scored within the first 32 seconds of the overtime period.

Goal-Games

Winnipeg finished the season 12-5-11 in one-goal games... Meanwhile, the Jets were 10-12 in games decided by two goals and 17-15 in games decided by three goals or more.

Zeros

The Jets had five shutouts last season, which is two shy of the franchise record... The Jets beat the Seattle Kraken on Dec. 9 and Detroit Red Wings on Jan. 13 by a 3-0 score, while they shut out Minnesota 2-0 on Jan. 8, Vegas 4-0 on Mar. 22, and Philadelphia 4-0 on Apr. 27... Winnipeg was shut out four times this season as well.

Afternoon Meetings

The Jets went 5-4-2 in afternoon games last season... Kyle Connor led the Jets in scoring in day games with 10 points (8G, 2A) in 11 games.

KC Wins The Byng

Kyle Connor won the NHL's Lady Byng Trophy last season, given "to the player adjudged to have exhibited the best type of sportsmanship and gentlemanly conduct combined with a high standard of playing ability"... Connor had just four penalty minutes en route to tallying 93 points (47G, 46A).

Single-Season Records

Kyle Connor finished third in franchise history with 47 goals last season. The most goals in a season in franchise history is 52, which Ilya Kovalchuk did in 2005-06 and 2007-08. Connor passed Patrik Laine (44 in 2017-18) for the most goals in a season since relocation... Kyle Connor ended the season fourth in franchise history with 93 points last season, which is the most since relocation. It's the eighth time in franchise history a player has reached the 90-point mark in a season... Pierre-Luc Dubois' 15 power play goals ended the season tied for eighth in franchise history and are the most since Patrik Laine had 15 power play tallies in 2018-19... Kyle Connor and Adam Lowry each had three shorthanded goals this season, which ranks tied for fourth in franchise history. Only three players in franchise history have scored four or more shorthanded goals in a season.

28 or More

For the first time in franchise history, the Jets had four players score 28 goals or more in a season... Aside from Kyle Connor's team-leading 47 goals, Mark Scheifele had 29 goals, while Pierre-Luc Dubois and Nikolaj Ehlers had 28 goals each... The previous high was three, which was done five times.

Defensive Offence

Winnipeg's defencemen accounted for 32.7% of the team's assists and 24.2% of points... Josh Morrissey led the Jets defencemen in scoring with 37 points (12G, 25A) in 79 games... Neal Pionk had the most assists among rearguards with 31... Brenden Dillon boasted a plus-16 rating in 79 games, while Dylan DeMelo was plus-10 in 76 contests.

Home Cookin'

Kyle Connor led the Jets in scoring at home last season with 41 points (21G, 20A) in 40 games... Mark Scheifele's 22 home goals last season is tied for sixth most in a season in franchise history... Scheifele also had the single-season franchise record 25.3% shooting percentage at home this season... Blake Wheeler led the Jets with 30 assists at home this season, which is eighth in franchise history... Paul Stastny led the Jets with a plus-19 rating at home, which Nikolaj Ehlers was a plus-18.

Hit Squad

Adam Lowry led the Jets with 231 hits last season, which is the second most of his career... Brenden Dillon (212), Neal Pionk (184), and Logan Stanley (131) also averaged two hits or more per game last season.

On the Farm

The Manitoba Moose shut out the Rockford IceHogs 4-0 on Sunday afternoon to take three of four points in their season-opening series with Rockford... The Moose begin a three-game, three-night road trip on Friday when they tangle with the Chicago Wolves... Manitoba finished second in the AHL's Central Division last season with a record of 41-24-7... The Moose went to Game 5 against the Milwaukee Admirals in their North Division semifinal series, but lost 2-1 to lose the series... Mikey Eyssimont paced Manitoba during the regular season with 42 points (18G, 24A) in 58 games... Declan Chisholm led the Moose in scoring in the playoffs with seven points (2G, 5A) in five games.
