JETS NOTES

- » Are now 12-5-0 at Canada Life Centre this season.
- » Improved to 9-2 this season when following a loss.
- » Held the opposition to three or fewer goals for a 23rd time in 32 games this season. The Jets are 19-3-1 this season when allowing three or fewer goals.
- » Scored five or more goals for an 11th time this season, which is tied for second in the NHL. The Jets have also scored four or more goals 16 times this season, which is tied for fifth in the NHL.
- » Both Kyle Connor and Josh Morrissey extended their point streaks to 10 games. It marks just the second time in franchise history two players have had double-digit point streaks in the same season (Mark Scheifele, Blake Wheeler in 2015-16).
- » Took just four penalty minutes on two infractions. The Jets have taken fewer than 10 penalty minutes in 22 of 32 games this season, and have taken the 12th fewest penalty minutes in the NHL (274).
