Winnipeg Jets: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Rick Bowness

Rick Bowness was appointed as the eighth head coach in franchise history on July 3, 2022 and the third head coach since the club's relocation to Winnipeg.

Bowness, 67, most recently served as head coach of the Dallas Stars from Dec. 10/19 until the end of the 2021-22 season. The Moncton, N.B. native led the Stars to an 89-62-25 record in 176 regular season games. Dallas also went 18-16 in the playoffs, highlighted by a trip to the 2020 Stanley Cup Final.

Bowness was drafted in the second round in the 1975 NHL Draft by the Atlanta Flames. Bowness played 45 games for the Jets 1.0 in the 1980-81 season and he played and coached with the organization for nine seasons until 1988-89.

Following his time with the Jets, Bowness has served in a number of different coaching capacities at the NHL level for the Boston Bruins, Ottawa Senators, New York Islanders, Phoenix Coyotes, Vancouver Canucks, Tampa Bay Lightning, and Dallas. He has a 258-384-79 record as an NHL head coach.

Bruce Cassidy is in his first season as the head coach of the Vegas Golden Knights after being named the franchise's third head coach on June 14, 2022. Recap: After falling behind 4-1 in the second period, the Jets scored three consecutive goals in the third period, including Adam Lowry's tally with 22 seconds left to force overtime. However, Mike Amadio scored for Vegas 3:40 into the second overtime period to give the Golden Knights a 5-4 win and 2-1 series lead. Neal Pionk had three assists for the Jets, while Kyle Connor had a goal and assist while leading the Jets with eight shots.

Trailing

The Jets can do something they have never done in franchise history if they come back to win this series – win a series when trailing two-games-to-one... The Jets have trailed a series 2-1 three times in franchise history – 2018 Western Conference Final vs. Vegas (lost in five games), 2019 first round vs. St. Louis (lost in six games), and 2020 qualification series vs. Calgary (lost best-of-five in four games).

On the Kill

The Jets are 10-for-12 (83.3%) on the penalty kill through the first three games of the series, which ranks fifth in the NHL during the playoffs... Game 3 marked the first time in the series the Jets surrendered a goal on the penalty kill.

Feeling the Power

The Jets have scored a power play goal in three consecutive games to start the series, going 3-for-10 (30.0%)... This is the first time in the Jets have started a playoff series with a power play goal in three consecutive games... The franchise record for most power play goals in a playoff series is five, which was done in the second round of the 2018 playoffs against the Nashville Predators.

All About the Hits

The Jets lead the NHL in playoffs with 193 hits, which is 25 more than second place Vegas... The two sides combining for 361 hits is the most of the eight first round playoff series through the first two games... Pierre-Luc Dubois is tied for second in the playoffs with 19 hits, while Brenden Dillon, Neal Pionk, and Nino Niederreiter have 17 hits each.

Streiking

Adam Lowry joins Chris Kreider of the New York Rangers as the only two players in the NHL to start the playoffs with a goal in their first three games... Lowry has four goals in the first three games of the series, which is nearly half of his nine career playoff goals... He has just one three-game goal streak during the regular season (Feb. 25-Mar. 1/22)... Neal Pionk is one of six players to have an assist in the first three games of the playoffs... His three-assist game in Game 3 tied a franchise record for most assists in a playoff game.

Shooting Range

Kyle Connor leads the NHL in playoff shots with 21 through the first three games, including eight in each of the past two games... Connor led the Jets with 273 shots in 82 games during the regular season for an average of 3.33 shots per game.

Playoff Experience

Entering the playoffs, nineteen players on the Jets roster had Stanley Cup Playoff experience, totalling 624 games and 249 points (87G, 162A)... Nino Niederreiter leads the Jets players with 84 games of playoff experience with Minnesota and Carolina... Brenden Dillon is second with 77, while Nate Schmidt is third with 70, including 47 with Vegas.

Playoff Debuts

Defenceman Dylan Samberg and forwards Morgan Barron and David Gustafsson made their Stanley Cup Playoff debuts in Game 1... The trio have played all three games in the series.

Overtime Winners

Four members of the Jets have scored overtime goals in the Stanley Cup Playoffs, led by Kyle Connor's pair of OT winners... The Jets franchise is 4-4 in playoff overtime games, including winning three overtime games in the First Round of the 2021 Stanley Cup Playoffs against the Edmonton Oilers.

Clinched

With a win over the Minnesota Wild in the penultimate game of the season, the Jets secured the final playoff spot in the NHL's Western Conference... It's the fifth time in the past six seasons that Winnipeg will compete in the NHL's Stanley Cup Playoffs... The Jets have played 37 playoff games during the past six seasons, which is the most among the seven Canadian teams in the NHL, and have the second most wins with 17.

Against the Pacific

Winnipeg went 13-8-3 against the Pacific Division this season... Kyle Connor (12G, 17A) led the Jets with 29 points in 24 games against the Pacific Division during the regular season, while Mark Scheifele had 14 goals in 24 games, including seven of his 12 power play goals.

Strong Finish

The Jets ended the season 7-4-0 in their last 11 games, including 4-2-0 in the month of April... The Jets scored 26 goals in their last seven games after scoring 15 goals in their previous nine games... Josh Morrissey led the Jets in scoring in April with seven points (1G, 6A) in five games, while Mark Scheifele (3G, 2A), Pierre-Luc Dubois (2G, 3A) and Nikolaj Ehlers (2G, 3A) each had five points.

All 82

Four members of the Jets played in all 82 games during the regular season – Kyle Connor, Brenden Dillon, Adam Lowry, and Neal Pionk... Connor, Dillon and Lowry reached 82 games for the second time in their career... Pionk played all 82 games for the first time in his career... The Jets didn't have anyone play all 82 games last season.

Backend Production

Jets defencemen combined for 192 points (46G, 146A) during the regular season, which is seventh in the NHL... Josh Morrissey (76), Neal Pionk (33), Dylan DeMelo (27), Brenden Dillon (23) have all reached the 20-point mark, while Nate Schmidt has 19 points... Defencemen have accounted for 27.8% of Winnipeg's points this season, which is fourth in the NHL, and 18.7% of the team's goals, which is second... With Morrissey having 16 goals and Pionk scoring 10, it's the third time in franchise history and second time since relocation that the Jets have had multiple defencemen with 10 goals in the same season.

Road Record

The Jets were 20-20-1 on the road this season... The Jets have posted a .500 or better record on the road in six of their past seven seasons... Kyle Connor (13G, 21A) led the Jets in scoring on the road with 34 points in 41 games... Mark Scheifele had a team leading 20 goals, which is the 11th time in franchise history a player has reached 20 goals on the road in a season.

PK Prowess

Winnipeg finished tied for seventh in the NHL this season with a penalty kill successful 82.6% of the time... The last time the Jets had a penalty kill better than 82% was in 2013-14 when they finished the season at 83.2%... The franchise record for penalty kill percentage in a season is 85.2%, which occurred in Atlanta during the 2003-04 season.

Special Difference

The Jets finished fourth in the NHL by playing 45:41 more on the power play than the penalty kill... Winnipeg had 56:43 of more power play than penalty kill time at home, which was second in the league... Winnipeg finished 23rd on the power play during the regular season at 19.3%.

Comebackers

The Jets had 17 comeback wins in the regular season, which was tied for 15th in the league... Winnipeg had to come back from a deficit in 37% of their wins, which was 24th in the league... Pierre-Luc Dubois led the Jets with seven game-tying goals in the regular season, while Mark Scheifele had 6... Scheifele and Kyle Connor each paced the team with 15 go-ahead goals.

Margins

The Jets played 27 games in the regular season that were decided by one goal, going 17-7-3... The 27 games were tied for fourth fewest in the NHL... On the other side of the spectrum, Winnipeg was 19-19 in 38 games decided by three goals or more, which was tied for fifth most in the NHL.

Team Leader

Kyle Connor led the team in scoring with 81 points (32G, 49A) in 82 games... Connor reached 80 points and 40 assists for the second consecutive season... He's also reached 30 goals for the second consecutive season and fifth time in his career... Connor finished one shy from hitting the 50-assist mark for the first time in his career... Connor also led the Jets last season with 93 points (47G, 46A) in 79 games, which was the fourth most points in a season in franchise history... He had a pair of hat tricks this season and his four hat tricks are tied with Nikolaj Ehlers for fourth in franchise history.

Record Maker

All-star defenceman Josh Morrissey set a franchise record for most points by a defenceman with 76 points (16G, 60A) in 78 games, which was second on the Jets... He has also established a career high with 60 assists, which is also now the franchise record for assists in a season by a defenceman... He is the 11th NHL defenceman in the past 10 seasons to have 60 assists in a season... He joins Marc Savard (2005-06) and Blake Wheeler (2017-18 and 2018-19) as the only players in franchise history to have 60 assists in a season... Morrissey has also passed the career high 12 goals he had last season with 16... He has joined Dustin Byfuglien as the only defencemen in franchise history to post back-to-back 10-goal seasons... Morrissey ended the season tied for second in the NHL among defencemen in scoring.

Sniper

Mark Scheifele tied for ninth in the NHL with 42 goals this season, which is a new career high... Scheifele reached the 40-goal mark for the first time in his career, besting the career high 38 goals during the 2018-19 season... Scheifele's 40-goal season is the 10th occurrence in franchise history and it's just the second time since relocation in 2011 – Kyle Connor 47 goals in 2021-22 and Patrik Laine 44 goals in 2017-18 – that player has scored 40 goals in a season... Scheifele also set a franchise record for most game-winning goals in a season with 10, which was fourth in the NHL during the regular season... Scheifele also had 11 multi-goal games, which is a career high.

Workhorse

Goaltender Connor Hellebuyck was tied for the NHL lead during the regular season with 64 games played and finish tied for fourth with a .920 save percentage... He reached the 60-game mark for the fourth time in his career and earned his fourth shutout of the season in the third last game of the season, which tied him for fifth in the NHL... He was second in the NHL with 3,778 minutes played this season and was the first goaltender this season to pass the 3,000 minutes played mark... Hellebuyck led the NHL in games played in 2017-18 (67), 2019-20 (58), and 2020-21 (45) and minutes played in 2017-18 (3,966) and 2020-21 (2,603)... Prior to the last game in Colorado, he started 13 consecutive games for the Jets to end the regular season, posting a 1.93 goals-against average and .927 save percentage in those games... Since the 2018 playoffs, Hellebuyck has started all 35 playoff games the Jets have played, going 16-19 with a 2.46 goals-against average and .921 save percentage.

Extra Time

The Jets went 10-3 in overtime (9-2) and shootouts (1-1) during the regular season, which led the NHL with an .769 winning percentage... Winnipeg played in just two shootouts this season, going 1-1... It's the fewest shootouts they've played in franchise history... Six of Winnipeg's nine OT winners came in the first two minutes of the extra session... Mark Scheifele holds the franchise record with 13 OT winning goals... The nine wins is four more than Winnipeg had last season in 12 games decided in OT... During the past three seasons, Winnipeg is 20-10 in games decided in overtime... The franchise record for OT wins is 10, set in 2010-11.

Zeros

The Jets registered four shutouts in the regular season... Winnipeg's first two shutouts were by 4-0 scores (Oct. 24 vs. STL and Nov. 5 vs. CHI), while the Nov. 29 5-0 shutout against Colorado gave the Jets three shutout wins by at least four goals... The Jets had five shutouts last season, which is two shy of the franchise record... Winnipeg was shut out six times this season, which is the most in a season since the Jets were shut out seven times during the 2011-12 season.

Taking the Challenge

Head Coach Rick Bowness made six challenges during the regular season, resulting in four calls being overturned... All four challenges resulted in goals being overturned to no goals – two for offside, one for interference, and one for a stoppage... The Jets are 3-1-0 in games this season when they have made a successful coach's challenge... Opposing coaches made four challenges in games this season against the Jets, going 2-for-4.

The Moose finished the season in third place in the Central Division with a 37-25-10 record... Alex Limoges led the Moose in scoring with 54 points (20G, 34A) in 63 games, while Jansen Harkins had 50 points (25G, 25A) in 44 games.

Winnipeg Jets vs. Vegas Golden Knights Playoff Notes

Season Series

The Jets and Golden Knights played three times during the regular season, with the Jets going 0-2-1... Two of the three games were decided by one goal... Winnipeg only had four power play opportunities in the three games, going 1-for-4... Winnipeg outshot Vegas in the last meeting 34-33, but were outshot 113-86 overall in the three games... Mark Scheifele (3G), Adam Lowry (1G, 2A), and Neal Pionk (1G, 2A) each had three points in three games against the Golden Knights during the regular season... Goaltender Connor Hellebuyck posted a .913 save percentage in two starts against Vegas and faced an average of 40 shots per game.

All-Time Mark

The Jets are 8-4-2 all-time against Vegas during the regular season... Winnipeg's three-game winless skid against Vegas this season comes after a five-game winning streak that spanned from Nov. 2/19-Mar. 22/22... The Jets have a pair of 4-0 shutouts against Vegas, which both came at home – Mar. 6/20 and Mar. 22/22... Kyle Connor has feasted on the Golden Knights during the regular season with 21 points (10G, 11A) in 14 career games, but was held to one assist in the three games this season... Mark Scheifele has 15 points (8G, 7A) in 13 career games against Vegas, while Blake Wheeler has 13 points (1G, 12A) in 13 games.

Playoff History

Winnipeg and Vegas met in the 2018 Western Conference Final with the Golden Knights taking the series in five games... The first three games were decided by two goals, while the last two were one-goal games... The Jets lost both games of the series in Vegas... Blake Wheeler led the Jets in scoring in the series with six assists in five games... Only seven players that suited up for the Jets in that series are still with the team – Kyle Connor, Nikolaj Ehlers, Connor Hellebuyck, Adam Lowry, Josh Morrissey, Mark Scheifele, and Blake Wheeler... Jets defenceman Nate Schmidt played for Vegas in that series, recording an assist in five games.

Game 3 Recap

April 22 – Vegas Golden Knights 5, Winnipeg Jets 4 2OT

Michael Amadio was the hero in double overtime as the Vegas Golden Knights defeated the Winnipeg Jets, 5-4, in Game 3 on Saturday evening at Canada Life Centre. Vegas took a 2-0 lead early in the game as **Chandler Stephenson** and **Jack Eichel** each found the back of the net to put the visitors up by a pair. Kyle Connor scored late in the opening period and the Golden Knights carried the 2-1 lead into the second period. Eichel scored his second power-play goal of the game midway through the frame before **Keegan Kolesar** potted his first of the playoffs to give Vegas the 4-1 advantage. It was a different story in the third period as Nino Niederreiter, Mark Scheifele, and Adam Lowry scored to tie the game and send it to overtime. After the first extra session passed without a goal, Amadio fired the game-winner over the shoulder of Connor Hellebuyck to lead Vegas to victory in Game 3, 5-4.

VGK/WPG - Regular Season Recap

The Vegas Golden Knights owned a 3-0-0 advantage against the Winnipeg Jets during the 2022-23 regular season. The clubs began the season series with two contests at T-Mobile Arena just 10 days apart. In their first meeting, **Jack Eichel** tallied his first multi-goal game of the season to lead the Golden Knights to a dominant 5-2 win over the Jets. In their next matchup, Eichel was the overtime hero as he snuck the puck past Connor Hellebuyck to send the Vegas crowd to a frenzy. In their final meeting at Canada Life Centre, **Mark Stone** and **Jonathan Marchessault** each had two goals to help Vegas power past Winnipeg despite Mark Scheifele's late hat trick. Winnipeg was one of 10 NHL teams that Vegas swept during the regular season.

It's A-Me Amadio

Michael Amadio scored his first-ever playoff goal to allow Vegas to take Game 3 in double overtime in Winnipeg, 5-4. Amadio finished the game with his first-career multi-point game in the postseason with his assist on **Jack Eichel's** second goal (1-1—2) to go along with the game-winning goal.

Jack of All Trades

Jack Eichel became the first player in Golden Knights history to score two power-play goals in a playoff game. Eichel also factored on **Keegan Kolesar's** goal to become the second player to record three points (2-1—3) in a road playoff game (also **Jonathan Marchessault**, GM3 of 2021 R2 vs. COL). Eichel leads Vegas in postseason points so far with four (3-1—4) in three games.

Powered By Petro

Defenseman **Alex Pietrangelo** has had back-to-back games with two assists. Pietrangelo's multi-point performances tie him with Carolina's Brent Burns for fifth in the NHL in career playoff points by active defensemen (12-5—67).

L-Beast

In **Laurent Brossoit's** 10 starts during the regular season, five of them required an extra session. Brossoit was in net for a career-high 84:14 minutes in his first-career double overtime game. Brossoit made 30 saves as he helped Vegas capture Game 3 and take a 2-1 lead in the series with Winnipeg.

Easy Steve-y

Chandler Stephenson scored the opening goal in Game 3 to give himself tallies in consecutive playoff games for the first time in his career. Stephenson's goal in Game 2 against Winnipeg was his first game-winning goal in his playoff career. Stephenson had previously gone 17 playoff games without a goal, dating back to 9/14/20.

Aye-Aye Captain

Mark Stone exploded on Thursday in Game 2 as the Vegas captain had three points (2-1—3) in the third period to push the Golden Knights past the Jets. Stone made his return to the lineup in Game 1 against Winnipeg after missing the Golden Knights' final 39 games of the season due to injury. Stone's multi-goal game makes him the second highest postseason goal scorer in franchise history with 20, just one behind club leader, **Jonathan Marchessault** (21). It marked his third career playoff game with three-plus points, all with Vegas, and his fourth career multi-goal playoff game, also all in Vegas.

The Iron Man

Phil Kessel completed his 13th consecutive full season, extending his NHL-record ironman streak to 1,064 consecutive regular season games played. Kessel owns an NHL-record ironman streak of 1,147 games *including playoffs*. The forward has the third most career

postseason points among active U.S.-born players with 34-49—83 points in 99 games played (behind Patrick Kane 53-83—137 in 139 GP and Joe Pavelski 64-62—126 in 169 GP).

Rulers of the Realm

For the third time in six seasons, the Golden Knights finished first in the Pacific Division (2017-18, 2019-20 previously) and entered the postseason as the number one seed in the Western Conference for the first time.

Keeping it One Hundred 🎯

Vegas completed the regular season with a franchise-high 111 points. This is the second time in Golden Knights history the club reached the 100-point mark and first since its inaugural season in 2017-18 (109). Vegas was the first team in the Western Conference to hit 100 points this season and the only club to surpass the 110-point mark in the West.

Bench Boss Butch

Bruce Cassidy recorded 50 wins in back-to-back years after accomplishing the feat last season with the Bruins (51-26-5, 107 points). He is the first coach in NHL history to record at least 50 wins in consecutive campaigns with a different franchise each time.

x – Marks the Spot

Vegas is the seventh franchise in NHL history to reach the Stanley Cup Playoffs five or more times in its first six seasons, after the Rangers (6 of 6), Blues (6 of 6), Oilers (6 of 6), original Ottawa Senators (5 of 6), Minnesota North Stars (5 of 6) and Quebec Nordiques (5 of 6).

In the Winning Business

Vegas (38-29 in 67 GP) has a postseason winning percentage of .567, the fourth highest among all NHL franchises behind Tampa Bay (.584), Edmonton (.581) and Montreal (.577). The Golden Knights can become the fourth club in League history to reach 40 postseason victories in 70 games or fewer, following the Oilers (40-19 in 59 GP), Ducks (40-28 in 68 GP) and Islanders (40-28 in 68 GP).

The Misfits

Six original Vegas Golden Knights remain with the club and have made an appearance in all five playoff runs: **William Carrier**, **William Karlsson**, **Jonathan Marchessault**, **Brayden McNabb**, **Reilly Smith**, and **Shea Theodore**. Smith (14-38—52 in 69 GP) is the franchise leader in playoff points and assists, while Marchessault (21-26—47 in 69 GP) tops the club's leaderboard for postseason goals. Karlsson ranks second in career playoff scoring for the team and is one point shy of 50 (19-30—49 in 69 GP). Theodore (12-35—47 in 69 GP) is the Golden Knights' all-time leader for playoff goals, assists, and points among defensemen.

O from the D

Vegas' blue line produced a large part of the team offense with **Alex Pietrangelo** (54 Pts) and **Shea Theodore** (41 Pts) leading the front during the regular season. The Golden Knights' d-core accounted for eight game-winning goals, half of them coming in overtime, and **Alec Martinez** led all Vegas skaters with a +30 rating on the season.

Pietrangelo matched his career-high 54 points on April 11 (11-43—54) and set a record for points by a Vegas defenseman (prev. 52, Theodore) which he surpassed on April 6.

Marty's Block Party

Alec Martinez led the NHL with 244 blocked shots, a career-high, in 77 games played and was the only skater to hit the 200 mark during the regular season. Martinez ranks tied for sixth for most blocked shots in a season in NHL history since the league began tracking in 2002-03.

Brayden McNabb (second) and **Alex Pietrangelo** (seventh) were also both in the NHL's top 10 in blocked shots this season with 198 and 177, respectively. As a team, Vegas led the NHL with 1,494 blocked shots.

So Clutch

Alec Martinez (LAK 2OT of Game 5 in 2014) and **Alex Pietrangelo** (STL Game 7 in 2019) each have a Stanley Cup-clinching goal. Vegas is one of three clubs in the postseason with multiple players with a Cup-clinching goals (also COL & TBL).

Former Champs

Alex Pietrangelo (2019 STL), **Ivan Barbashev** (2019 STL), **Chandler Stephenson** (2018 WSH), **Jonathan Quick** (2012 LAK), and **Alec Martinez** (2012 LAK) can all help a *second franchise win its first Stanley Cup*. The last players to achieve that feat were Dustin Penner (2007 ANA & 2012 LAK) and Justin Williams (2006 CAR & 2012 LAK), teammates of Quick and Martinez at the time.

* *Phil Kessel has also previously won Stanley Cups with Pittsburgh (2016 & 2017) but were not the first for the franchise*

Spreading the Wealth

In the regular season, 13 Golden Knights had recorded 10+ goals and 20+ points, and 21 had 10 or more points. **Jack Eichel** led the club with 66 points, followed by **Chandler Stephenson** with 65 points, and **Jonathan Marchessault** with 57 points.

First Things First

The Golden Knights finished second in the NHL in first period goals with 87, trailing only Edmonton (92). Vegas had the second largest goal differential in the opening period, outscoring their opponents 87 to 57, and tied for the third least goals allowed in the first.

Clean Hockey

The Golden Knights finished the regular season with the least amount of penalty minutes with 566 and the least penalties per 60 minutes, 3.19 (tied SJS). Vegas has 13 skaters with less than 20 PIM this season and none are past the 70-minute mark.

Beasts of the East

For the first time in franchise history, the Golden Knights reached 20 wins this season against the Eastern Conference, as Vegas' win at home against Columbus March 19 wrapped up the club's Eastern Conference competition for the regular season. The Golden Knights finished the season with a 22-8-2 record against the Eastern Conference (12-4-0 Atlantic, 10-4-2 Metropolitan).

Comeback Kids

The Golden Knights led the league with 11 third-period comeback wins in the regular season. Vegas outscored its opponents 87-81 in the third period, won eight in overtime, five in a shootout and had a .292 win-percentage when trailing after the second period (second in NHL).
