Jets Notes

- » Improve to 37-15-5, which is currently tied for first in the Central Division.
- » Stay hot at home, wining now five in a row at Canada Life Centre.
- » Have been dominant after leading two periods this season (28-1-1).
- » Have now won eight straight against Central Division teams, 16-3-1 for the season.
- » Tied a season-high in goals in the first-period goals with three, and have tied that mark in two consecutive games.
- » 25-3-1 this season when scoring first, have now scored the first goal in four straight games.
- » Go perfect on the penalty kill for the 28th time this season (3-for-3).
- » Unable to score on the power play for just the second time in the past six games (0-for-2).
- » Have now won seven of the last eight games.
- » Sweep the season series against St. Louis going 3-0, the first time going undefeated against the Blues since the 2016-17 season (5-0).
- » Outhit St.Louis 25-15, and have now posted 25+ hits in five of the last six games.
- » Continue to be perfect when scoring four or more goals (23-0-0).

Player Notes SEAN MONAHAN

- » Notched his 19th goal of the season, and now has six goals in the past five games.
- » Earned his first assist as a Jet.

NIKOLAJ EHLERS

- » Marks his 40th point of the season with his first assist, the sixth time in his career hitting that mark.
- » Earned his third multi-assist game of the season.

JOSH MORRISSEY

- Extends his season-longest point streak to five games with two assists (0G,11A)
