Jets Notes

- » Suffer their first loss of the season and drop to 8-1-0.
- » Snapped a 16 regular season game win streak (dating back to last season).
- » Fall to 4-1-0 at Canada Life Centre this season.
- » Allowed six goals in a game for the first time since 03/23/2024 against the Calgary Flames.
- » Allowed the most goals in a period this season with three
- » Gave up 19 shots in the first period, most shots given up in a period this season.
- » Remain first in the NHL on the power play with notching two goals (2-for-4)
- » Went perfect on the penalty kill going 2-for-2, sixth time this season going 100% on the kill.
- » Allowed the first goal for the fifth consecutive game.

Player Notes

Kyle Connor

- » Extends his point streak to nine games (8G, 6A), becomes the first player in franchise history to have a start of season point streak reach nine games.
- » Notched two power play goals for the third time in his career.
- » Ties the league lead in power play goals with four
- » Marked a four point outing for the seventh time in his career (2G, 2A).
- » Led the team in shots with seven.

Josh Morrissey

- » Notched three assists, he is now tied for second in the NHL for points by a defencemen with 11 (1G, 10A)
- » Led the team in ice-time with 27:04.

Nikolaj Ehlers

Extends his point streak to six games with an assist

» Notched his fourth multi point game of the season (1G, 1A).

Adam Lowry

» Led the team in hits with six.

» Earned his second multi point game of the season (1G, 1A)
