Jets Notes

- » Lost the third consecutive game, but remain at the top of the NHL (27-12-2).
- » Fall to 14-4-2 at Canada Life Centre this season, which snapped a seven-game home point streak.
- » Despite the three-game losing streak, the Jets have gone 9-4-2 in the past 15 games.
- » Went 0-for-2 on the power play, it's the second time this season that the Jets power play has gone scoreless in three consecutive games.
- » The penalty kill went 2-for-4, it's just the fourth time this season that they have allowed two or more goals on the kill.
- » Have allowed four or more goals in three consecutive matchups for the first time this season.

Josh Morrissey

- » Scored his fourth goal of the season to snap a nine-game drought.
- » He became the second defenceman in franchise history to score 70 career goals.

Nino Niederreiter

- » Extended his point streak (3A) to three games with an assist.

Vladislav Namestnikov

- » Notched an assist and has now hit the 20-point mark for the ninth time in his career.

Logan Stanley

- » Led the team in blocks with three.
