Jets Notes

- » Snapped a three game winning streak and fall to 31-13-3 which is second in the NHL.
- » Drop to 18-5-3 at Canada Life Centre, it remains the best home record in the league.
- » Finished the season long eight game homestand going 4-2-2.
- » Outshot Calgary 38-22, it was the first time this season that they have outshot the opponent but still lost (21-1-1).
- » Fifth time this season that they have been held to one goal.
- » Sixth consecutive game of not allowing more then two goals (not including empty net goals).
- » The penalty kill allowed a goal for the first time in four games (1-for-2).
- » The power play was unable to capitalize when they had the chance for the first time in five games (0-for-2).

Player Notes

Adam Lowry

» Scored his 11th goal of the season, he's four goals shy of tying his career high (15).

Colin Miller

» Notched his seventh assist of the season in his first game since coming back from injury.

Logan Stanley

» Earned his eighth point of the season with an assist.

Mark Scheifele

» Had a season high in shots with seven which also led the team.

Josh Morrissey

» Led the team in ice-time with 24:48.

Eric Comrie

- » Lost his eighth consecutive start which matches the longest in franchise history (Milan Hnilicka in the 2002-03 and 2000-01 seasons).
- » He has held the opponent to two goals in each of his past two starts.
