– Matias Maccelli scored a goal tonight, giving him four points in his last four games (1/14-1/20: 3g, 1a). He has scored five goals in his last eight games (1/4-1/20: 5g, 1a), topping his total from the first 37 games of the season (10/8-12/31: 3g, 7a).
 – Liam O’Brien registered 11 hits tonight, marking his second-highest single-game total during his NHL career (2/28/23 vs. CHI: 13) and the most by any Utah skater in a game this season (**Jack McBain**, 1/10 vs. SJS: 9). Only Kiefer Sherwood (VAN) has posted a higher single-game total in 2024-25, with 12 hits at CHI on 10/22.

HAYTERS GONNA HAYT

– **Barrett Hayton** earned a season-high three points (1g, 2a) tonight for his sixth multi-point game and third multi-assist outing of the season.
 – He has posted three or more points in five games during his NHL career, most recently tallying a career-high four points (2g, 2a) against MIN on 3/12/23.
 – Hayton also scored the eventual game-winning goal, and his four winners in 2024-25 are now tied with **Clayton Keller** for the team lead.
 – He has now registered five points (1g, 4a) and two multi-point outings over his last three games (1/16-1/20), after posting two assists against NYR (1/16).
 – Hayton has tallied nine points in his last 10 games at Delta Center (12/22-1/20: 4g, 5a) and ranks fourth on the team in home scoring over that span.

FOR WHOM THE KELLS TOLLS

– **Clayton Keller** tallied two points (1g, 1a) tonight for his team-leading 12th multi-point game of the season.
 – Keller extended his assist/point streak to four games (1/14-1/20: 2g, 7a), marking the longest home assist streak by any Utah skater in 2024-25. He is now just one game shy of matching his own five-game run (12/14-12/23: 4g, 6a) for the team’s longest assist streak of the season.
 – He has now posted 30 points over his last 22 games (11/30-1/20: 10g, 20a), with 20 points (7g, 13a) in 13 contests at Delta Center over that span.
 – Keller has also found the scoresheet in 15 of his last 19 games on home ice (10/28-1/20: 8g, 17a), and he has posted multiple points in six of his last 12 games at Delta Center.
 – With his assist on Utah’s opening goal tonight, he has also assisted on four of Utah’s last six go-ahead goals dating back to 1/14 vs. MTL.

KEEPING IT COOLS

– **Logan Cooley** extended Utah’s lead in the second period tonight, lighting the lamp for the fourth straight game (1/14-1/20: 4g, 2a).
 – He has now tied for the longest goal streak of any Utah skater in 2024-25 (also **Kevin Stenlund**, 12/7-12/12: 4g; **Dylan Guenther**, 12/12-12/20: 6g, 1a), and for the team’s longest home goal streak this season (also **Mikhail Sergachev**, 10/28-11/15: 4g, 2a).
 – Cooley has now earned a point in 22 of his last 27 games (11/23-1/20: 12g, 18a), including 15 of his last 18 contests (12/12-1/20: 8g, 12a). He has also found the scoresheet in nine of his last 11 games at Delta Center (12/18-1/20: 6g, 6a).

HERE TO ASSIST

- **Nick Schmaltz** posted two assists tonight for his 10th multi-point game and team-leading eighth multi-assist game of the season.
- He extended his point streak to six games (1/10-1/20: 3g, 5a), marking the longest home point streak by any Utah skater in 2024-25 (previous: **Clayton Keller**, 10/28-11/18: 1g, 4a in 5 GP). He is also just one game shy of tying **Dylan Guenther** (12/7-12/20: 6g, 5a in 7 GP) for Utah's longest point streak of the season.
- Schmaltz has now found the scoresheet in 10 of his last 11 games at Delta Center dating back to 12/18 vs. VAN (4g, 8a).
- **Josh Doan** also tallied two assists tonight to register the first multi-point game of his Utah Hockey Club career and his fourth such performance in the NHL. Tonight's game marked his second career multi-assist outing, with his only other two-assist game coming with Arizona on 3/28/24 vs. NSH.
- Doan has recorded five points (2g, 3a) in 15 games with Utah this season, including three points in his last four games (1/14-1/20: 1g, 2a).

ON POINT

- **Olli Määttä** opened the scoring for Utah tonight, with his tally marking his first goal of the season and the first of his Utah Hockey Club career.
- After being held without a goal in 13 straight games (12/20-1/16: 20a), Utah's defensemen have now lit the lamp in back-to-back games (also **Michael Kesselring**, 1/18 vs. STL).

LABOR OF GLOVE

- **Connor Ingram** stopped 23 of 25 shots faced in net tonight, including all 17 of the Jets' shots over the first two periods, to improve to 8-5-3 in 2024-25.
- He has now posted back-to-back wins in his return to the lineup (also 1/18 vs. STL: 22/24), marking his first consecutive victories since his season-opening, three-game win streak (10/8-10/12).

HOME SWEET HOME

- Utah closed its season-long, seven-game homestand tonight against Winnipeg.
- Following back-to-back wins (also 1/18 vs. STL), Utah finished with a 3-4-0 record on the homestand.
- **Clayton Keller** (2-9-11), **Logan Cooley** (5-3-8) and **Nick Schmaltz** (3-5-8) led the team in scoring over that stretch.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Utah went 0-for-2 on the power play tonight and is now 28-for-129 (21.7%) on the man advantage in 2024-25. Utah was also 0-for-0 on the penalty kill and is now 123-for-151 (81.5%) on the kill this season.
- Winnipeg went 0-for-0 on the power play tonight and are now 43-for-134 (32.1%) on the man advantage in 2024-25. The Jets were also 2-for-2 on the penalty kill and are now 100-for-126 (79.4%) on the kill this season.
