Jets Notes

- » Extend their win streak to three games as they tie the Washington Capitals for first place with 71 points (34-14-3).
- » Improve to 20-5-3 at home this season, it's the best home record in the league.
- » Tied the second fastest team in franchise history to 20 home wins (28GP).
- » Improve to 19-0-2 when leading after the first period and 25-0-1 when leading after the second. They are the last remaining team to have yet to lose in regulation when leading after an intermission.
- » Held their opponent to under 30 shots for the 12th consecutive game.
- » Win the season series against Calgary for the first time since the 2021-22 season (2-1-0).
- » Have scored five or more goals for the 16th time this season which leads the league (16-0-0).
- » Scored multiple power play goals for the 11th time this season (2-for-2).
- » Have gone 100% on the power play in consecutive games for the first time this season.
- » Have now allowed goals in the penalty kill in two straight games (1-for-3).
- » Logged the second most hits registered this season (32).
- » Have held the opponent to two or fewer goals for the eighth time in the past 10 games.

Player Notes

Dylan Samberg

- » Notched his sixth assist of the season.

Kyle Connor

- » Notched his 27th goal of the season which ties the team lead and is tied for fourth in the league
- » Marked his seventh three-point game this season (1G,2A).

Mason Appleton

- » Earned his seventh goal of the season and his first in his past nine games.

Gabriel Vilardi

- » Extended his point streak to three games (3G, 3A).
- » Tied a career high for points in a game with four (2G, 2A).
- » Marked his eighth multi-goal game of his career (2G).
- » He's now one goal shy of tying his career high in goals (23).
- » He ranks fourth in the NHL in power play goals (11).

Mark Scheifele

- » Marked his 16th multi-point outing this season (1G,1A).

David Gustafsson

- » Earned an assist to extend his point streak to three games which is the longest streak of his career.

Nikolaj Ehlers

- » After an assist in tonight's game, he now has six points in the past four games (1G,5A).

Eric Comrie

- » Snapped a franchise long eight-game losing streak.
