Zach Hyman leads the NHL in goals from 10 feet or less since the beginning of the 2023/24 season. One came tonight and two of those came on Tuesday against Utah. Most goals from 10 feet or less since 2023/24:

- 1. Zach Hyman EDM 52 (1 tonight)
- 2. Gabriel Villardi WPG 35
- 3. Chris Kreider NYR 34

To the Viktor Go The Spoils

Viktor Arvidsson skated in his 600th career game tonight:

- He had goals in two straight games coming into tonight.
- He sits at 35th all time in goals among Swedish forwards.
- He is 7th all time in goals in Predators history (127).

Skinny Love

Jeff Skinner posted his 12th and 13th goals of the season:

- He was one goal shy of recording Edmonton's first hat-trick of the season.
- It is his first multi-goal game against the Jets.
- It is his 57th career multi-goal game.
- It is his first multi-goal game as an Oiler.
- It is his first multi-goal game since March 18th, 2024.
- He has points against the Jets in 3 of his last 5 games (2G, 3A).

Looking Ahead

The Oilers will look to get back into the win column this Saturday (Mar. 22nd) at Rogers Place for their penultimate match against the Seattle Kraken. Edmonton will then take a 3-day break before returning to the ice on Wednesday (Mar. 26th) for a home tilt against the Dallas Stars. The Oilers will conclude the season series against the Seattle Kraken on the road (Mar. 27th) before returning to Edmonton for the final Battle of Alberta of the season (Mar. 29th).

An Apple a Day Keep the Doctor Away

Darnell Nurse posted two assists tonight:

- He is fourth among Oilers defencemen with 21 apples on the season.
- He posted his 29th career 2+ assist game.
- It was his 3rd 2+ assist game of the season.
- It was his first 2+ assist game since December 14th, 2024.
- It is his second career 2+ assist game vs. the Jets (January 26th, 2021 3A that night).

Clear For Take Off

Connor McDavid has been rolling as of late:

- With a point tonight he extends his point streak to 13 games (longest active streak in NHL)
- He needs two goals to become the 5th Oilers player with 200 goals on home ice and can achieve it in the third-fewest games (currently at 352 GP at home), only trailing Wayne Gretzky (211 GP) and Jari Kurri (281 GP).
- He has recorded 57 points (12G, 45A) in 33 career games vs. the Jets (1A tonight).

Zach Hyman on playing without McDavid and Draisaitl: "First time, I think since I've been here that they've both been out in a game. So [it's] obviously a little different but it's an opportunity for guys to step up and show our depth right? I mean, you're missing the two best players in the world but we've got a really good team, so I think it's a great opportunity."

Darnell Nurse on the teams penalty-kill: "I think we're just playing with instinct out there on our toes. You know, a lot of the times when you get scored on the PK, [it] forces you to get on your heels and let other teams do what they want. And I think we dictated the play a little bit when we were out there on the PK."

Jeff Skinner on other the team stepping up in the third period and overtime: "I mean, it goes to OT and it goes either way obviously. But yeah, a lot of guys stepped up. Obviously Picks [Calvin Pickard], that's a tough situation to walk into and he's huge on the PK. I thought the PK was great all night, a lot of guys stepped up. It was nice to see and nice to be a part of."

JETS

Kyle Connor on the overall play tonight: "I thought we had a couple looks, but overall we were sloppy. That is something we take pride in., to be able to close out a game. You know, we got a five on three, didn't score on that... We got to continue. I like our team game. I like our team game and we have got to continue to be motivated and not be satisfied and look to improve."

Chris Tanev on winning against a good team: "We got the result we wanted with two points as big coming into against a good team playing in their building, but there are some things we need to get better at. Good teams find a way to win, and we [won tonight]."

Coach Scott Arniel on the state of the game: "I think both teams turned pucks over, but we did what we had to do on the last game of a road trip."
