- » Opened their best-of-seven Western Conference First Round Playoff series with a victory.
- » Improve to 7-5 in game ones of a playoff series.
- » Snapped a four-game losing streak in the playoffs.
- » Have now gone 9-19 at home in the playoffs.
- » Scored the latest go-ahead goal in franchise history in the playoffs with 1:36 remaining in regulation.
- » Won their fifth playoff game by third period comeback.
- » After setting their franchise record 23 comeback wins in the regular season, they quickly earned their first of the postseason.
- » Marked the second time in the past 10 playoff games that they have scored five or more goals.
- » Outshot St. Louis 26-17, it was the third time in franchise history that they've held their opponents to under 20 shots in the playoffs.
- » Were outthit 53-33.
