Jets Notes

- » Defeated the Blues for the second straight game and now lead the seven-game series 2-0.
- » Improve to 4-8 in Game 2s of a playoff series.
- » First time winning consecutive playoff games since their 2021 series vs Edmonton.
- » Have now gone 10-19 at home in the playoffs.
- » Scored the first goal of the game for the first time in the series.
- » Third time in franchise history that they have gone up 2-0 in a playoff series (2018 Round 1 vs. MIN and 2021 Round 1 vs. EDM).
- » Outhit St. Louis 33-29.
- » It was the second time in franchise history that they have won a 2-1 game in playoffs (Apr. 16/19 vs. STL).

Mark Scheifele

- » Notched his second goal of the playoffs.
- » Has posted back-to-back multi-point outings and now has five points in two games (2G, 3A).
- » He is the first player in franchise history to record multiple points in each of their first two contests of a playoff year.

Dylan DeMelo

- » Marked his fifth career playoff point with an assist (1A).

Connor Hellebuyck

- » Won consecutive playoff games for the first time since 2021.
- » Eleventh time in his career that he has held the opponent to one goal or fewer in the playoffs.

Player Notes

Cole Perfetti

- » Recorded his first career playoff point with an assist.

Luke Schenn

- » Led the team in hits with seven.

Kyle Connor

- » Earned his second goal of the postseason and now has four points in two games (2G, 2A).
- » Became the fourth player in the past 20 years to score the game winning goal in consecutive games to open the playoffs.

Dylan Samberg

- » Led the team in ice-time with 24:30.

Mason Appleton

- » Led the team in shots with four.
