Jets Notes

- » Won their first game of the series and have now tied the series up 1-1 in the Second Round of the Stanley Cup Playoffs.
- » Got back into the win column at Canada Life Centre and improve to 5-1 which is the best home record in the playoffs.
- » Have held their opponent to under 30 shots for the ninth straight game in the playoffs, it's the longest streak since the New York Islanders in the 2020 Stanley Cup Playoffs (10GP).
- » Third multi-goal first period in the playoffs (2G).
- » Opened the scoring for the first time this series.
- » Entered the third frame with the lead for just the second time in the playoffs (2-0).
- » Shutout their opponent for the fourth time franchise history in the playoffs and the first time since shutting out the Edmonton Oilers 1-0 in Game 2 in Round 1 of the 2021 Stanley Cup Playoffs.

Player Notes

Gabriel Vilardi

- » Marked his first goal of the postseason and now has points in two consecutive games (1G, 1A).

Nikolaj Ehlers

- » Notched his first and second goals of the playoffs which snapped a 14-game playoff goal drought.
- » Set a new career playoff game high with three points (2G, 1A).
- » Marked his second career multi-goal outing in the playoffs (2G).
- » Led the team in shots with seven.

Haydn Fleury

- » Earned an assist and now has points in consecutive playoff games for the first time in his career.

Josh Morrissey

- » Registered his fourth point of the playoffs with an assist.
- » Led the team in ice-time with 22:39.

Nino Niederreiter

- » Earned his second assist of the playoffs and now has five points (3G, 2A) in the past five games.

Adam Lowry

- » Notched his fourth goal of the playoffs which ties a postseason career high (Four goals in the 2023 playoffs).

Dylan DeMelo

- » Marked a new career high with his third and fourth points of the postseason (1G, 3A).
- » Registered his first career multi-point outing in the playoffs (2A).

Mark Scheifele

- » Extended his point streak to three games with an assist and now has points in all five home playoff games (3G, 4A).

- » Led the team in hits with six.

- » Led the team with three blocks.
